



Policy 34-00 Public Comment

Sponsor: District Governing Board

Policy

The District Governing Board (the Board) Chair may offer the public time to speak at Board meetings to address the Board on issues concerning the College. The Board may subject public comment to reasonable time, place, and manner restrictions. Unless the public comment relates to agenda items under consideration at that meeting, Board action is limited to directing staff to study or schedule the matter for future consideration.

Individuals addressing the Board shall state their name, affiliation, and subject being addressed. Organizations or groups wishing to address the Board will select a spokesperson that will be recognized to address the Board. Individuals who fail to observe public comment procedures and appropriate public decorum may be denied further opportunity to address the Board and may also be expelled from the meeting.
